Aerial Lift Training Peoria - The mechanical access platform referred to as an aerial work platform is a machinery that provides access to areas that are otherwise inaccessible to individuals and other equipment. Likewise known as an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machine is often used to be able to access high places. Construction and maintenance staff usually need to utilize aerial work platforms on the job. Firefighters use them for emergency access.

The aerial work platform is meant to temporary use, providing access to high areas. They are meant to be operated by one individual, with the capability of lifting weights of not more than one ton. Some types have higher load limits. There are various types of aerial work platforms; for example, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

Various aerial work platforms are available equipped along with electrical outlets or compressed air connectors for power tools. For specialist jobs, like for instance lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform could come with special tools.

Anybody required to operate an aerial lifting machinery needs training, together with their supervisors. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial machine work areas also have to go through training. Those training would become familiar with how to operate an aerial lift machine. They will also learn the regulations that apply to the safe operation of these machinery. Regulations vary from province to province, and within federally regulated worksites.

Workers who work near or are required to be lifted by an aerial lifting machinery needs to know all the potential hazards. An Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown in a general safety session to educate all of the employees who are lifted by them or work near them.

Aerial Lift Training Program includes modules focused on the following: Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Hazard Identification; Platform Positioning & Park Positioning and Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices. The particular program is meant to train workers on the safe operation of boom-supported, self-propelled elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. A certificate would be given to employees who complete the program, signed by a qualified individual to verify successfully finishing a hands-on practical exam.
