Back injuries because of incorrect lifting methods are another common danger.

Warehouse machines carries inherent dangers. Injuries or accidents can be caused by forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks if they are not operated properly. Warehouse tools, like pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, have to be utilized cautiously throughout loading, packing and unpacking.
